36 **3. US Department of Agriculture Airport Report**

37
38 Airport Manager Barth said the USDA is on contract with the Colorado Department of
39 Transportation (CDOT) to do wildlife hazard assessments at Colorado airports. They are about 5
40 months into an assessment at Longmont airport and will be giving some of their observations.

41
42 Jason Kouger, Wildlife Biologist with the USDA Wildlife Services spoke to the board. Mr.
43 Kouger said the assessment is a twelve month ecological study of wildlife use of the airfield as
44 well as a five mile radius of offsite hazards. He states the assessment will conclude in August of
45 2015.

1 Mr. Kougher presented the observation report on animal species at the airport. He states he has
2 observed 44 different wildlife species, bird and mammal, including humans, at the airport. He
3 commented that he observed older couple walking on the taxiway.

4
5 Kendra Cross passed out a CertAlert to the board members. Ms. Cross said the purpose of the
6 CertAlert is to give recommendations. She said when the wildlife recommendations are made
7 they are based on the airport needs and responsible management. If something were to happen, it
8 could be catastrophic. The current fencing around the airport is adequate for larger animals and
9 pedestrians, but is not going to keep off wildlife 100 percent. She said the FAA will appreciate
10 the due diligence in trying to keep wildlife out of the airport.

11
12 Ms. Cross states it has been great working with Airport Manager Barth on this project.

25
26 Mr. Barth introduced the agenda item. He states in the past three days there has been some
27 grumblings that have come out of FAA headquarters in Washington D.C. FAA was under
28 congressional mandate to have UAV rules and regulations in place by 2015 and 2017 and FAA
29 told congress the mandate was unfair. All commercial operations will still have to be flown
30 under a COA, however the FAA has started to allow 12 different companies commercial use of
31 UAV with a COA and they do not have to be sponsored by a government agency.

32
33 Skip Miller, CEO of UAS-USA, introduced his company. They are a commercial drone
34 company that he started five years ago in Colorado. He went through a presentation with the
35 board about the company and equipment. He states he has been blown away by the reception
36 from the city of Longmont. He thanked Airport Manager Barth for supporting their company.

3 **5. Elite Aviation Annual Report**

4
5 Brian Pickerell, General Manager of Elite Aviation, gave a report to the board on activities over
6 the last year. All went well with the transition from the old Air West business. They are
7 continuing the remodel the office after delays due to the flood. He talked about the staff and
8 what a good team he has. They have added line service with someone available seven days to
9 help with fueling and answer questions. Mr. Pickerell said they will continue to promote the
10 flight simulator and will be promoting the community movie night in the summer. They have
11 joined the Longmont Chamber of Commerce and were active with the flood operations and
12 recovery.

13
14 Mr. Pickerell spoke about some things they would like to do this year. He states they would like
15 to have a courtesy car available to people flying in, get a twin aircraft for training, a ground
16 power unit for corporate jets, de-icing equipment, and work on line staff training for emergencies
17 and other activities. He said they would also like to get some signage for their business and a
18 sign at the entrance of the airport to direct people around the airport. They are also looking at the
19 probability for mountain flying seminars.

20
21 Mr. Pickerell said some things the City and the airport could do to help them are a longer
22 runway, help with the business community to encourage flights coming in, getting a snow plow
23 for the airport or plow the runway sooner, and equipment for braking action.

24

39 **6. Elite Aviation Fuel Farm Proposal**

40
41 Airport Manager Barth states Elite Aviation is in the process of moving forward with a new fuel
42 farm proposal.

43
44 Sherry Binkley and Todd Frickin are with F&D International in Boulder. They are the architects
45 working with Elite Aviation on this project. Mr. Frickin said a goal for Elite was to look into a
46 new fuel dispensing system. The current system is an underground tank and they want to

1 increase their fuel capacity and eliminate the underground tank. They have identified two
2 possible locations. He said they did look at available data regarding the volume of fuel that has
3 been sold to determine the size of the tanks needed. He said they also wanted to be sure the
4 aircraft could pull up to the fuel pump without blocking the taxiway and be able to have aircraft
5 also “que” up. They are looking for comments from the board before they draw up full
6 construction plans for the project.

7

22 **7. CDOT-A Grant Program**

23
24 Airport Manager Barth states all 76 airports in Colorado were notified that the Division of
25 Aeronautics had misplaced 12 million dollars in grant funding to airports. He said there is only 3
26 million dollars available in 2015 for grant funding. He said the impact of this will push
27 everything in the airport’s capital improvement program back to at least 2018 or 2019. The
28 runway extension was dependent on this funding, as well as pavement maintenance and snow
29 plows. He states the 3 million dollars remaining will only be used to match federal grants that
30 the FAA has awarded. A memo from the former director of CDOA is included in the board
31 packet and there is an ongoing investigation into where the money went.

32
33 Airport Manager Barth states he did call FAA to get some funds to help with the pavement and
34 was able to convince them to give \$150,000 in entitlement funds for this year, plus borrowing an
35 additional \$150,000 from Sterling or Erie for 2016, giving the airport \$300,000 in funds for
36 pavement rehabilitation. He said the State of Colorado has no choice but to automatically match
37 the grant out of the 3 million dollars. He states the airport will be maintained at a level to keep it
38 safe.

39
40 **8. 2014 Airport Annual Report**

41
42 Airport Manager Barth felt the airport had a pretty significant year. He said noise abatement is
43 the big focus. Some projects that were completed in 2014 were the fence installation, hosting the
44 Sister Cities program, the two year process for the rules and regulations, and bringing in two
45 UAV companies to the airport.

1 Airport Manager Barth states the noise complaint log is sent to City Council each year.
2

3 Chairman Dolce states the database shows a total of 1,650 total complaints, with about 450
4 considered “valid” complaints. The complaints are coming from a 50/50 split between city and
5 county residents. The highest level of complaints at 80 percent is for skydiving, with 16 percent
6 for general aviation, 2 percent for helicopters and 2 percent for UAV’s/ultra-lights/jets. He said
7 not much has changed from 2013 with one complainer that was significant, probably using
8 maybe an automated system to fill in data coming to the airport. He said some of the high hitters
9 need to be looked at more thoroughly to see if they are technically outliers in the data.
10

11 **NOTE:** Copy of complaint log was not provided in the packet materials or at the meeting.
12

13 **9. FAA Grant Award**

14

15 Airport Manager Barth said there is going to be a \$300,000 grant coming to Longmont for
16 pavement rehabilitation in several areas of the airport. The airport fund will provide a match at
17 \$16,667 and the State of Colorado will provide the rest of the matching funds. Airport Manager
18 Barth is asking the board to approve the grants at this time so it can go to City Council as soon as
19 it is ready.

33 Airport Manager Barth discussed how the board interacts with staff and the community and how
34 board members are to handle themselves.
35

36 Council Member Santos gave the instruction on board member’s responsibilities and behaviors.
37 He discussed email conversations, attendance of the board members, and what constitutes a
38 meeting.
39

40 Assistant City Manager Lewis encouraged the board to call if there are any questions or if they
41 need information. He advised the board if they knowingly violate the rules or regulations of the
42 board, they are personally liable for that and they would no longer be covered under the City’s
43 legal process.
44

45 Council Member Santos advised the board member that people are always listening.
46

1 Assistant City Manager Lewis informed the board he will be filling in as the interim Airport
2 Manager until a new one is named and will work out at the airport two days a week. The Airport
3 Manager final interviewing process will be happening Friday, January 16. He hopes an offer can
4 be made very soon after the interviews are complete. He said the City is committed to the airport
5 and believes it is an economic engine for the community and an important transportation link.
6 He states Airport Manager Barth provided him with a list of projects and timelines of airport
7 operations to keep things running smoothly through the transition.
8

9 Council Member Santos said the airport is an asset to the city and as a Board; they are trying to
10 make the airport the best it can be. He the City Manager sees the airport as an economic driver
11 for the city and the commitment is there.
12

13 Airport Manager Barth states outside legal assistance is coming from Kaplan, Kirsch and
14 Rockwell to assist the city with a host of issues, including the airport rules and regulations to be
15 sure they are compliant. He said Jviation is also looking at the documents and will come back to
16 the airport board.
17

18 Airport Manager Barth said the 30 year lease amendment is in ongoing discussions.
19

20 Airport manager Barth states the fence issues have been taken care of and updated the board on
21 the final walk through. Once final payment is made, the city can work on grant reimbursement.
22

23 Suggestion was made by Board Member VanZant to put signs up before getting to the gate and
24 the keyboard consoles; it is dark and sometimes hard to see at night. He said snow is getting
25 pushed into the fence during snow removal.
26

27 **Final Call – Public Invited to be Heard**

28

29 Chairman Dolce opened the final call – public invited to be heard.
30

31 Jeff Bowman. Mr. Bowman rents one of the hangers on the west side of the airport. Snow
32 removal needs to happen in the area in front of his hanger, he could not get out. When he did get
33 out, he got stuck and it was a dangerous situation. He commented that Elite Aviation does a
34 great job at the airport.
35

36 No one else wished to speak.
37

38 Chairman Dolce closed the final call public invited to be heard.
39

40 **Board Comments**

41

42 Board Member Wohler commented that he joined the board 20 years ago and at that time the
43 board welcomed the new Airport Manager Tim Barth. He finds it ironic that he was on the board
44 then and 16 years later he is on the board when Airport Manager Barth is leaving. He wished
45 Tim the best of luck in his new job.
46

1 Board Member DaHarb thanked Tim for all his work at the airport.

2

3 Chairman Dolce commented that Tim has done a great job at the airport and wished him luck in
4 his new job.

SUBJECT: Update on Selection of a New Airport Manager

Over a two week job posting period, the City of Longmont received nearly 50 applications for Vance Brand Airport Manager. Many of these candidates met the minimum qualifications of the position. As the supervisor of the Airport Manager, I reviewed all applications, narrowing the candidates down to 16. Using the internet-based software application Skype, I interviewed 16 of the most qualified applicants. From that group, I intended to narrow the field to three, but there were six highly-qualified and impressive candidates that were chosen for in person interviews.

The interview panel consisted of AAB Chair Don Dolce, AAB Vice Chair Dale VanZant, AAB City Council Liaison Gabe Santos, Elite Aviation Owner Julie Meyers, Airport Hangar Association President Anita Bragg, Airport Hangar Association Member Marc Arnold (chosen by the Hangar Association Officers), Assistant Finance Director Molly Kostelecky, City Manager Harold Dominguez and me. After five and a half hours of interviews, the group made the difficult (because of so many excellent candidates), but unanimous decision on a finalist. Reference checks were completed and were very positive.

The Airport Fund will pay the selected candidate the mid-point of the salary range, and will assist with relocation costs and short-term temporary housing until the candidate and his family can purchase a home.

On Monday, a press release with the candidate's name will be provided to City Council and each of you just prior to the press release being provided to the media.

Many thanks to the interview panel, City of Longmont Human Resources staff and the City Manager's Office Administrative Assistant Maria Tostado for helping coordinate and select this exceptional candidate.

SUBJECT: Presentation of Noise Complaint Log & Analysis

The draft 2014 Airport Noise Complaint Log & Analysis is attached. A prior analysis was voluntarily conducted by a member of the Airport Advisory Board. That analysis contained filtering formulas which resulted in the appearance of fewer complaints than the number shown in the "Raw Data" tab of the attached spreadsheet. That prior analysis was sent to former Airport Manager Tim Barth, and subsequently to a member of the public, but was rejected by current City staff on the grounds that it did not accurately portray total complaints received.

The staff of the City of Longmont, as a matter of policy, does not attempt to skew or distort data of any kind for any reason. The noise complaint analysis which contained filtering formulas has been removed from the Airport Manager's electronic information network drive. However, there are circumstances in which the City will invalidate complaints. Examples include multiple complaints on one noise incident from the same person and submitting complaints to the City via an automated/sound-activated computer system.

The attached spreadsheet provides the following information:

- Complaints by source of noise (i.e.: skydiving, UAV, jet, etc.)
- A summary of where complaints came from, either Boulder County, City of Longmont or unknown
- A breakdown of the number of complaints per complainant
- Raw Data including the name and address of the complainant, type of complaint, the previous Airport Manager's response to the complaint, etc.

Once reviewed and accepted by the Airport Advisory Board, a summary of the complaint numbers (along with other information reviewed at last month's AAB meeting in the Airport Annual Report) will be included in the final 2014 Airport Annual Report which will be included in an upcoming City Council agenda packet.
